Chiropractic Visits

I hope this finds you in good health. Unfortunately, pain and injury doesn't stop just because of a pandemic. I have given this a lot of thought and want to remain available if you need assistance. The following is how I will be handling your need for care during this pandemic.

At this time, due to sensible self-isolation and social distancing I am changing the office policy to by appointment only. If you need to be seen please call me at 603 356-2471 and I will give you an appointment time. For the time being there will be no walk-in visits allowed.

In addition, the waiting room is now closed. If you arrive at the office and see another car in the parking lot, other than my red truck, PLEASE wait in your car until whoever's car it is leaves the office and goes to their car. This will avoid contact with others in the office.

On entering the office please wash your hands immediately for 20 seconds and thoroughly dry them. Viruses will transfer more easily onto damp or wet hands.

Please use the stylus when signing in at the kiosk. I will change the stylus after you are done so the next patient will have a clean one

After each patient, I am cleaning the adjusting table and other surfaces with a virucidal cleanser to avoid transmission of Covid 19.

Until I receive the first call of the day I will not be in the office but can arrive there within 15 minutes of your call.

The necessary steps will protect us all.

Hopefully these procedures will only be in place for a few weeks. The most effective and fastest way to eliminate Covid 19 is social distancing and isolation. Just like any other viral infection, if you are not exposed to it you will neither become infected or transmit it to others.

Appointments will be available Monday, Wednesday, and Friday from 9 am to Noon and 2 pm to 4 pm.
